

**GDPR information clause for participants of the „8th INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR ON MODERN POLYMERIC MATERIALS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL APPLICATIONS – MPM203” conference, Kraków, Poland, 17-19 May, 2023.**

According to art. 13 par. 1 and par. 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (general regulation on data protection ), hereinafter referred to as the GDPR, Cracow University of Technology informs that:

1. the administrator of personal data is Cracow University of Technology (CUT) with headquarter in Cracow at ul. Warszawska 24, 31-155 Cracow, Poland;

3. your personal data will be processed for the purpose of organizing the 8th INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR ON MODERN POLYMERIC MATERIALS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL APPLICATIONS – MPM203 conference, Kraków, Poland, 17-19 May, 2023, hereinafter referred to as the Conference, and to promote its activities in the media, on the basis of Article 6 (1) (a, b) of the General Regulation on Personal Data Protection of 27 April 2016, and for the process of publishing the papers submitted for it, in particular:

- 3.1. Contact in organizational matters, including registration.

- 3.2. Making list of participants and badges.

- 3.3. Catering organization.

- 3.4. Publishing conference proceedings and publications promoting / documenting the organization of the conference.

4. The recipient of your data will be CUT employees performing activities related to the implementation of the above-mentioned purposes.

5. The administrator processes your personal data for the purpose of making contact with the participants of the Conference - the legal basis for data processing is the necessity of processing for purposes arising from legitimate interests pursued by the Administrator. In this case, the Administrator 's legitimate interest is contact with Conference participants (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR),

6. The administrator processes your personal data for the purpose of keeping statistics and reports as well as archiving for the Administrator's internal needs related to the number of event participants - the legal basis for data processing is the necessity of processing for purposes resulting from legitimate interests pursued by the Administrator. The Administrator's legitimate interest is to keep statistics and reports (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR),

- 7) Your personal data will be stored in the Administrator’s IT systems until you withdraw your consent, with the exception of data for financial management, which is stored in accordance with current regulations, and due to the nature of the placement of personal data in

the form of an image in the media, its storage period is not specified;  
8) the data subject has the right to access their data and the right to rectify, delete, limit processing, the right to data transfer, not to be subject only to automated decision making, the right to object and the right to file a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection in the event that data processing personal violates the provisions of the general regulation on the protection of personal data;

9) the data provided by you will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be subjected to profiling;

10) your personal data shall not be shared with any third country/international organization, unless this is required due to legal obligations of the Administrator.

We inform you that to document the Conference, photos may be taken during it, which may be then published on websites and in publications belonging to the Administrator.
